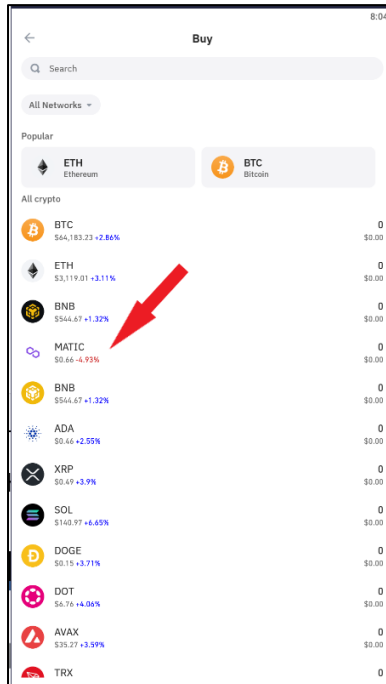
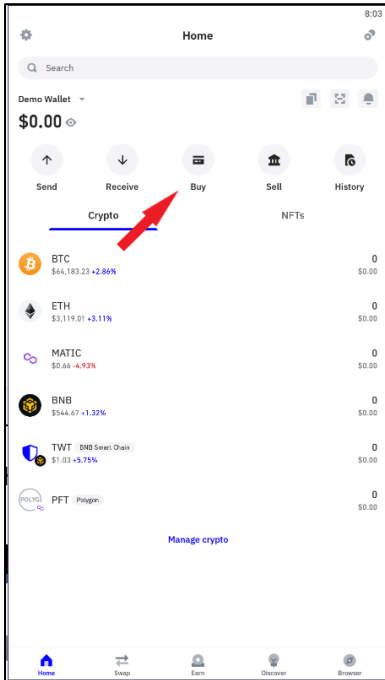


Buy Matic from within Trust Wallet

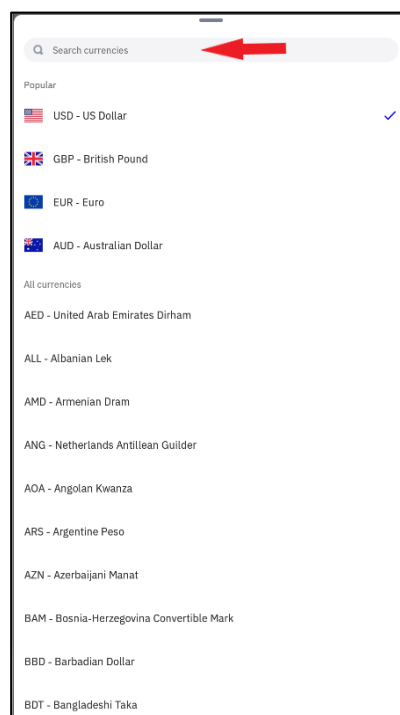
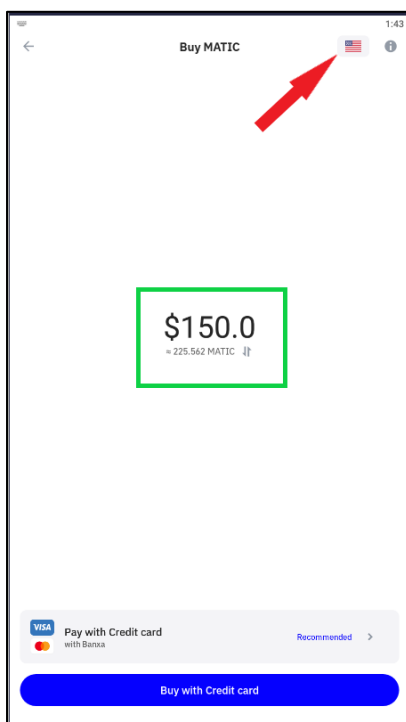

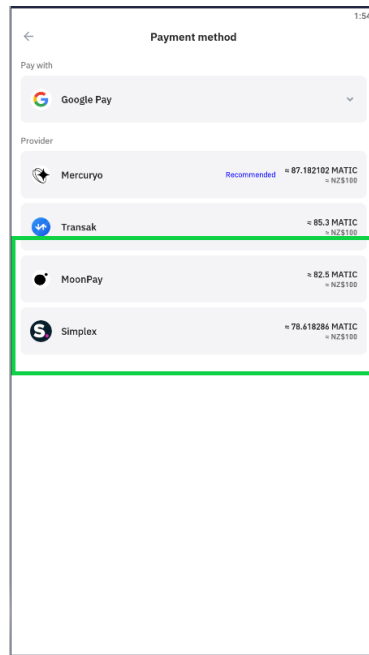
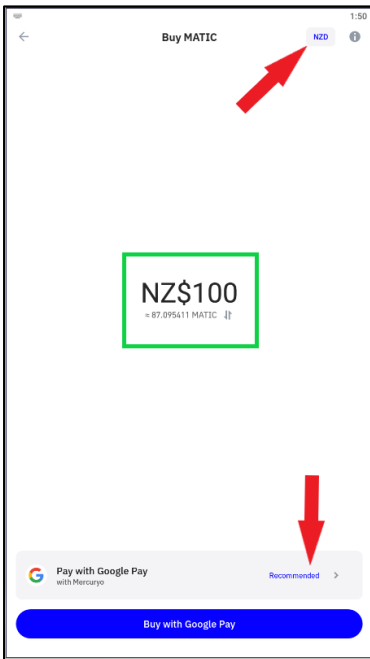
1. To buy PFT you must swap Matic for PFT so this details how to purchase Matic. Open your Trust Wallet and tap **Buy**. On the next screen select **Matic**.



2. In the next screen you will note top right that the amount shown is in USD. Tap the flag icon top right and in the search bar type New Zealand and then select it.

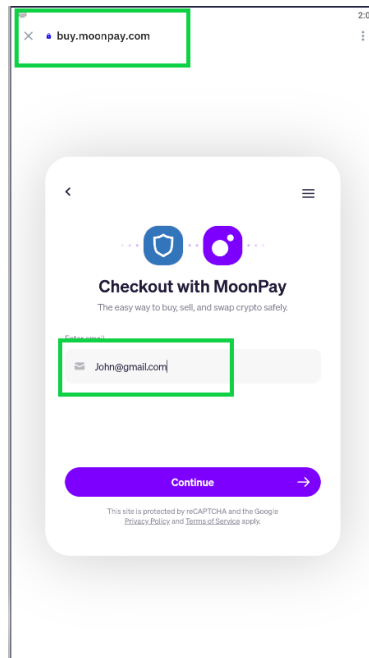
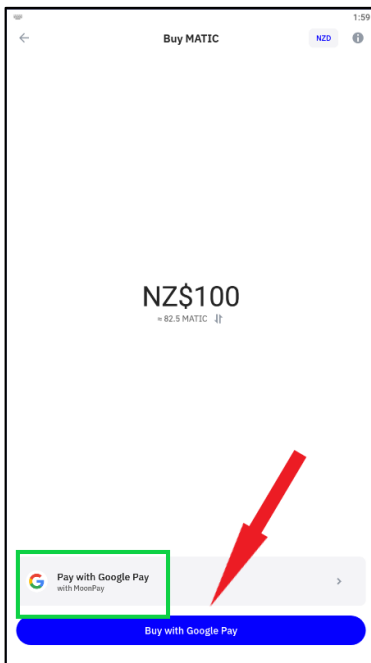


3. The values are now shown in NZD, type in the amount of NZD you wish to spend on Matic. Click the bottom right link which will take you to a list of organisations providing credit card purchase services.



Note: You may have a choice of providers like "MoonPay" or "Simplex". We have found both to be reliable.

4. All credit card providers must by law carry out a process called 'Know Your Customer' (KYC) as part of all crypto purchases to guard against money laundering.



5. At this point you are required to enter your email address, if you have not bought crypto from this provider you will then be stepped through the KYC process. It is very straight forward and the on-screen guidance while different for every provider is very good. Read what is required and then provide the detail.

6. The process takes only a few minutes and then when approved the crypto is delivered to your Trust Wallet normally within 30 minutes. You also get several emails advising you of the process. Check your emails and the links in them if any verification issue occurs.
7. This is a one-time only process, next time you buy on credit card there will be no KYC required. Check your trust wallet for the Matic by occasionally refreshing the wallet, to do this drag the screen down and release.

Please note: sometimes when first buying crypto directly with a debit or credit card the bank may block the transaction. If this happens you may need to contact your bank to manually approve the transaction. If that doesn't work, there are other alternatives via New Zealand retailers such as Easy Crypto.
